

APRIL 17, 2007, CONSOLIDATED GENERAL ELECTION - PROPOSITIONS

Village Of Carol Stream

QUESTION TO ISSUE \$25,000,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION LIBRARY BONDS OF THE VILLAGE OF CAROL STREAM

Shall bonds in the amount of \$25,000,000 be issued by the Village of Carol Stream, DuPage County, Illinois, for the purpose of constructing, furnishing and equipping a new public library facility at a site to be located at 480 North Kuhn Road in said Village and for the purpose of paying the costs thereof, bearing interest at not to exceed the rate of 9% per annum?

Village Of Hinsdale

OPERATE FOR HIRE A PUBLIC ELECTRIC UTILITY REFERENDUM

Shall the ordinance authorizing the Village of Hinsdale to operate for hire a public electric utility for the use and benefit of private consumers and users, and charge for such consumption and use be adopted?

Village Of Oak Brook

Shall the Village of Oak Brook increase the Non-Home Rule Municipal Retailers' Occupation Tax, in the amount of ¼% of the gross receipts of any sale of personal property, upon any person engaged in the business of selling tangible personal property at retail in the Village of Oak Brook; and shall the Village of Oak Brook increase the Non-Home Rule Municipal Service Occupation Tax, in the amount of ¼% of the selling price of all tangible personal property transferred by a serviceman, either in the form of tangible personal property or in the form of real estate, as an incident to a sale of service, upon all persons engaged, in the Village of Oak Brook, in the business of making sales of service to be used by the Village for expenditure on public infrastructure?

Winfield Township

PROPOSITION TO INCREASE TAX RATE FOR ROAD PURPOSES

Shall the limiting rate under the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law for the Winfield Township Road District, DuPage County, Illinois, be increased by an additional amount equal to .02% above the limiting rate for levy year 2005 and be equal to .1378% of the equalized assessed value of the taxable property therein for levy year 2007?

(1) The approximate amount of taxes extendable at the most recently extended limiting rate is \$1,317,433, and the approximate amount of taxes extendable if the proposition is approved is \$1,541,106.

(2) For the 2007 levy year the approximate amount of the additional tax extendable against property containing a single family residence and having a fair market value at the time of the referendum of \$100,000 is estimated to be \$6.67.

(3) If the proposition is approved, the aggregate extension for 2007 will be determined by the limiting rate set forth in the proposition, rather than the otherwise applicable limiting rate calculated under the provisions of the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law (commonly known as the Property Tax Cap Law).

Bensenville Park District

Shall bonds or notes of the Bensenville Park District, Cook and DuPage Counties, Illinois, to the amount of \$1,000,000 be issued for the purpose of paying the costs of constructing ball diamonds, soccer fields, a concession stand and related equipment for BBAA youth sports?

Lemont Park District

Shall bonds of the Lemont Park District, Cook, DuPage and Will Counties, Illinois, to the amount of Sixteen Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$16,200,000) be issued for building, maintaining, improving and protecting of the existing land and facilities of the District, including the construction and equipping of aquatic, wellness and community centers, and purchasing land for park purposes, and for the payment of the expenses incident thereto?

Roselle Park District

PROPOSITION TO ISSUE \$1,950,000 PARK BONDS

Shall bonds of the Roselle Park District, DuPage County, Illinois, to the amount of One Million Nine Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$1,950,000) be issued to acquire the property located at 230 E. Pine Street, Roselle, Illinois, commonly known as the Marklund Day School property, and build, maintain, improve and protect such property, including the demolition of the existing structure thereon, and to pay the expenses incident thereto?

Darien-Woodridge Fire Protection District

PROPOSITION TO ISSUE \$8,900,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS

Shall the Darien-Woodridge Fire Protection District, DuPage County, Illinois, pay debt of the District and acquire equipment and issue its bonds to the amount of \$8,900,000?

West Chicago Fire Protection District
PROPOSITION TO INCREASE LIMITING RATE

Shall the limiting rate under the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law for the West Chicago Fire Protection District, DuPage County, Illinois, be increased by an additional amount equal to .10% above the limiting rate for levy year 2005 and be equal to .6475% of the equalized assessed value of the taxable property therein for levy years 2007, 2008, 2009 and 2010?

- (1) The approximate amount of taxes extendable at the most recently extended limiting rate is \$4,708,577, and the approximate amount of taxes extendable if the proposition is approved is \$5,568,591.
- (2) For the 2007 levy year the approximate amount of the additional tax extendable against property containing a single family residence and having a fair market value at the time of the referendum of \$100,000 is estimated to be \$33.33.
- (3) Based upon an average annual percentage increase in the market value of such property of 5.74%, the approximate amount of the additional tax extendable against such property for the 2008 levy year is estimated to be \$45.70 and for the 2009 levy year is estimated to be \$58.82 and for the 2010 levy is estimated to be \$72.67.
- (4) If the proposition is approved, the aggregate extension for 2007, 2008, 2009 and 2010 will be determined by the limiting rate set forth in the proposition, rather than the otherwise applicable limiting rate calculated under the provisions of the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law (commonly known as the Property Tax Cap Law).

Winfield Fire Protection District

PROPOSITION TO INCREASE THE EXTENSION LIMITATION OF THE WINFIELD FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS

"Shall the extension limitation under the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law for the Winfield Fire Protection District, DuPage County, Illinois, be increased from the lesser of 5% or the percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index over the prior levy year to 12.5% per year for the levy years 2007, 2008, 2009 and 2010?"

- (1) For the 2007 levy year, the approximate amount of the additional tax extendable against property containing a single-family residence having a fair market value at the time of the referendum of \$100,000.00 is estimated to be \$8.67.
- (2) Based upon an average annual percentage increase in the market value of such property of 7.44%, the approximate amount of the additional tax extendable against the property for the 2008 levy year is estimated to be \$34.40; for the 2009 levy year the amount is estimated to be \$64.39; for the 2010 levy year, the amount is estimated to be \$97.64.

Poplar Creek Public Library District

PROPOSITION TO ISSUE \$22,700,000.00 LIBRARY BONDS

Shall the bonds of the Poplar Creek Public Library District, Cook and DuPage Counties, Illinois, in the amount of \$22,700,000.00 be issued for the purpose of remodeling and repairing the existing Main Library building, erecting an addition to it, improving the site, providing furnishings and all necessary equipment, and acquiring library materials and electronic data storage and retrieval facilities in connection therewith?

DuPage High School District 88

PROPOSITION TO ISSUE \$104,700,000 SCHOOL BUILDING BONDS

Shall the Board of Education of Community High School District Number 88, DuPage County, Illinois, be authorized to build and equip additions to and repair, alter and equip the Addison Trail High School and the Willowbrook High School buildings, improve the sites thereof and issue bonds of said School District to the amount of \$104,700,000 for the purpose of paying the costs thereof?

Bensenville Elementary School District 2

PROPOSITION TO ISSUE \$40,000,000 SCHOOL BUILDING BONDS

Shall the Board of Education of Bensenville Elementary School District Number 2, DuPage County, Illinois, alter, repair and equip the Blackhawk Middle School Building, build and equip two new elementary school buildings on existing school sites, and issue bonds of said School District to the amount of \$40,000,000 for the purpose of paying the costs thereof?

Glen Ellyn School District 41

PROPOSITION TO ISSUE \$40,000,000 SCHOOL BUILDING BONDS

Shall the Board of Education of Glen Ellyn School District Number 41, DuPage County, Illinois, improve the site of, demolish a portion of, build and equip additions to and alter, repair and equip the current Hadley Junior High School Building in order to convert said School Building into a middle level school campus housing two attendance centers for grades 5 & 6 and grades 7 & 8, improve the sites of, demolish portions of, build and equip additions to and alter, repair and equip other school buildings of said School District, and issue bonds of said School District to the amount of \$40,000,000 for the purpose of paying the costs thereof?

Butler School District 53

PROPOSITION TO ISSUE \$12,885,000 SCHOOL BUILDING BONDS

Shall the Board of Education of Butler School District Number 53, DuPage County, Illinois, build and equip additions to and alter, repair and equip the Brook Forest Elementary and Butler Junior High School Buildings, improve the sites thereof and issue bonds of said School District to the amount of \$12,885,000 for the purpose of paying the costs thereof?
